

DiGiD: Dutch Governmental Internet Registration Number

A] What is a DiGiD?

With your DigiD you identify yourself when you arrange Dutch matters online. Such as with the government, tax, social security, educational institutions, healthcare organizations or your pension fund.

Please note that your DigiD is private. Just like your passport or driving licence. Never give your username, password or PIN code to another person.

B] How do I apply for a DiGiD?

Go to <u>digid.nl/en/aanvragen</u> and fill in your details and complete your application:

- You will need your citizen service number called BSN for the application.*
- You will receive a letter with an activation code within 3 working days.
- Please include your phone number and e-mail address in your application. This will enable you to do more with your DigiD, such as resetting your password or activating the DigiD app easily.
- Remember your username and password, because you will need them to activate your DigiD.

* If you live abroad and do not yet have a BSN, please look on our site where we have a special form which explains how to request it from abroad.

C] Do you live abroad?

Do you live abroad and do you have the Dutch nationality or the nationality of another country in the European Economic Area (EEA)? Then you can apply for a DigiD.

Did you already have a DigiD before moving abroad? Then you can continue to use your DigiD.
